## Community and Homeowners Association Oyster Gardening Guidelines

The following guidelines are for homeowner's association docks, marinas & yacht clubs, and condominium & townhome docks. These only pertain to community docks and not private residence docks.

- One oyster gardener will be the community lead responsible for coordination of residents for the weekly maintenance.
- Each community will receive one set of supplies. Any additional supplies must be requested by the community lead to the Restore Our Shores team.
- A schedule should be created for organizing the community's oyster gardeners for weekly habitat maintenance.
- Each week, the scheduled gardener will need to clean the habitats and make sure the habitats return safely to the water within 8 hours postcleaning.
- The gardener doing the weekly maintenance should inform the community lead of any issues with the habitat, including tampering or theft.
- The community gardeners are responsible for their habitats and will need to contact the Oyster Gardening team in the event of property loss or damage.
- All communication to Brevard Zoo's Restore Our Shores team should be done through the community lead (<u>restoreourshores@brevardzoo.org</u>).
